The account of M^{rs} J. Sebell, Executrix with James E. Seery, h. d. W^m
Nicholas, Nicholas and Virginia L. Sebell legatus of Nicholas M.
Sebell dec^d was returned. And a Court held for the said County the 20th day
of August 1855. The said account having lain one month and upwards
in the Clerk's Office and there being no exceptions thereto was examined
and ordered to be recorded.

In the name of God, Amen! I, John Moore, of the County of Southampton and State of
Virginia, being of sound and disposing mind, and calling to mind the uncertainty of the mortal
lot, do constitute, ordain and make this my last will and testament as follows.

First:

Item 1st. My desire is to be buried with as little expense as decency will permit,
and that all my debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my decease
as conveniently may be.

Item 2nd. I give and bequeath unto my son Oris Moore the tract of land upon
which I now live being composed of two tracts, one purchased of Nathaniel Seely and
the other of Jeremiah C. Edwards, same I bequeath unto him and his heirs
forever, and I also give and bequeath unto my said son Oris Moore, one bed
and furniture, one cow and calf and one pair cart wheels.

Item 3rd. Unto my son George Moore, I have given and he is now in possession
of all the property I intend for him.

Item 4th. The remainder of my property after the payment of my debts and
funeral expenses, I give and bequeath unto my daughters Sally Cornwell,
the wife of John Cornwell and Catharine Stong, wife of Thomas A. Stong,
to be equally divided between them.

Item 5th. And lastly, I appoint my son Oris Moore as Executor to
this my last will and testament. In testimony of the same I have subscribed
my name and affixed my seal on this 23rd day of June 1854.

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 20th day of August 1855.
This last will and testament of John Moore dec^d was this day proved by the oath of
Elbert L. Stong and Lewis H. Cobb, two of the subscribing witnesses thereto and
thereupon ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of Oris Moore, the ex-
ecutor named, who made oath and gave bond and security according to law,
a Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said will in due
form.
