In obedience to an order of the County Court of Southampton County made at  
 August term last, recommending the account of William D. Howell, Esq. of Archer P. D.  
 Lindell, the Commissioner begs leave to make the following report. The Commissioner  
 was not aware at the time that he made his last report that the said William D.  
 Howell had ever returned any account of his transactions upon the estate of Archer P. D.  
 Lindell, and hitherto has proceeded to settle his account as if none had ever been  
 returned. He now finds that he has returned an account within the time pre-  
 scribed by law, and that the balance due by said report on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of  
 October 1848, was \$307.34 with interest on \$257.11 from date. The  
 Commissioner is of opinion that he has no authority to recoup the said  
 account for the purpose correcting errors, but that able to sue for and  
 satisfy said account must be brought. Be therefore reported the above balance  
 is due from the said Archer to the estate of his said intestate.
