The undersigned Commissioner of the County Court of Southampton County reports that on the 1st day of October 1854, at the request of Samuel Kello of Charles J. Bap dec'd. he appointed Tuesday the 21st day of November 1854 at his office in Greensboro for receiving proof of debts or demands against the said decedent in his estate and served notice of such time and place at the front door of the Courthouse of said County on the first day of two successive terms of the County Court of said County, to-wit: at October and November terms, at which time and place the creditors aforesaid appeared before the Commissioner and proved their several claims which with interest included up to the 31st day of Decr 1854, amount to \$81.89. The Commissioner reports that the balance due from the said admin on the 31st of Decr. 1854, was \$32.00, and the Commissioner has apportioned the said amount amongst the several creditors who have proved their debts as aforesaid in the account which will be found below.
