The undersigned Commissioner of the County Court of Southampton County reports that on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October 1854, at the request of Samuel Kello Admin<sup>r</sup> of Charles J. Bass dec<sup>d</sup>. he appointed Tuesday the 21<sup>st</sup> day of November 1854 at his office in Currituck for receiving proof of debts or demands against the said decedent in his estate and for the notice of such time and place at the front door of the Courthouse of said County on the first day of two successive terms of the County Court of said County, to-wit: at October and November terms, at which time and place the creditors aforesaid appeared before the Commissioner and proved their several claims which with interest includes up to the 31<sup>st</sup> day of Decr 1854, amount to \$81.89. The Commissioner reports that the balance due from the said Admin<sup>r</sup> on the 31<sup>st</sup> of Decr. 1854, was \$32.00, and the Commissioner has apportioned the said amount amongst the several creditors who have proved their debts as aforesaid in the account which will be found below.
