Item 4th I give to my granddaughter Caroline Simons ten of my dresses and the rest of my clothes to be divided between Mrs. Martha Travis and Mrs. Rebecca South my aunt dying

Item 5th I wish for Dr. Thomas L. Brown to become my Executor and William D. Apined to become my grand children's guardian

At a Court held in the County of Southampton the 18th day of August 1856.
This last will and testament of Elizabeth Simons dec^d was this day proved by the oaths of John S. Coker, Murdoch M. English and William D. English three of the subscribing witnesses thereto and thereupon ordered to be recorded. And Thomas L. Brown the executor therein named having refused to take upon himself the authority of the execution thereof, On the motion of Oliver S. Simons who made oath and together with Augustus James J. Lighthouse M. Bailey his securities (who justifies and swears as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledges above in the presence of five hundred dollars conditioned according to Law, Certificate is granted the said Simons for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of the said Elizabeth Simons dec^d with her will annexed in due form.

In the name of God: I, Littleton Moore, of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, being of sound mind and memory, do hereby make and publish this writing as my last will and testament in the manner and form as follows To wit:

Item 1st I give and bequeath the property I have hitherto advanced to each of my children to each of them and their heirs forever.

Item 2^d I give and bequeath unto my son William D. Moore one negro boy named Henry valued by me at eight hundred and fifty dollars to him and his heirs forever, with said neg^o boy my son William has now in his possession.

Item 3^d I give and bequeath unto my daughter Tabitha F. Daughtery one negro boy named Sam valued by me at eight hundred and fifty dollars to her and her heirs forever, with neg^o boy she has in her possession.

Item 4th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth M. Holland one negro girl named Blanche valued by me at five hundred dollars to her, her heirs and if she should die before her husband James M. Hollander then I bequeath the said neg^o girl to the said James M. Hollander during his life and after the death of my daughter Eliza
