The undersigned Commissioners of the County Court of Southampton County reports that at the request of Thomas Harcourt, adm^r of William Harcourt dec^d he appointed the 23rd day of July 1855 to receive proof of all debts or demands against the estate of the said William Harcourt dec^d. That he posted a notice of the time and place of receiving such proof at the Courtroom door of Southampton County on his successful and days prior; at January and February Term 1855. That on the day mentioned in said notice the several creditors whose debts are reported in the foregoing account appeared before him and proved to his satisfaction their several claims as aforesaid. That he gives the aggregate amount of debts inclusion of the amount due Thomas Harcourt on his account as Com^r of the said William Harcourt to be \$580.81. That they all belong to the
