

8thly. I give and bequeath to Marsena Johnson the infant daughter of Amasaiah Johnson all the sum of one hundred dollars the same in any respect under the same regulations of that given above.

9thly. I give and bequeath to Corbett Buffitt son of James Buffitt the tract of land lying in the forks of the roads called fishery & cypress road on which lands Polly Jackson and Polly Thomas their families now live say Sept. 1st 1856, containing about fifty four acres of land to his

10th I give and bequeath to my daughter James Davies of North's County N.C. my ^{own} share of my father's gave to me except such part thereof as I have heretofore and by this my will before disposed of all the two other small parcels of land lying adjoining the lands whereon I now live, one parcel I purchased many years since of Thomas Thomas Davies disposed to contain about thirteen acres of land the other lot or parcel large parcel land which I obtained part of right for say about fifty four acres of land altogether supposed to contain about one hundred and twenty acres of land, I further give to my said daughter James Davies my newest Dutch apple treehouse and brook, two brown stables, with their appurtenances, one iron kettle, one apple mill, two cider presses and their appurtenances, a parcel of traps, fifty six chair side casks to him my said nephew and to his heirs and assigns forever.

11thly. I give and bequeath jointly and equally to Doctor Leitch & Washburn, his wife, and to his sister Margaret Dandley for and during each their natural lives the West tract of land, the whole of which lands I now have inclosed by a rail fence say Oct. 1856, nevertheless I here provide that the timbers standing on the lands shall not be taken off the said land but go to improve, keep in good repair, such part of said plantation as may be deemed worthy of cultivation and but little if any of the new wood land. decayed of its natural growth and at and after the death of the longest live of the three persons to whom I thus devise give a life estate in and to, my will is that the premises thus disposed of for a time to come, at the end of the longest live that he or his representative as often as shall annually lease said land making suitable provisions for its improvement as I have done up to the time may sell or to fifty years next after my death and then sell said land and the money raise of and by such sale I give and bequeath one half thereof to Caroline F. Allen daughter of Marsena Allen, the other half of said money I give and bequeath to Marsena Johnson the infant daughter of Amasaiah Johnson to him and each of them said Lewis F. Johnson and to their heirs and assigns forever. But nevertheless, if either said Lewis or said Johnson shall die without issue of their bodies, I give said legacy thus bequeathed in such part be equally divided between James Hunt, Elizabeth Brown wife to Henry Brown, George Hunt, Thomas Hunt and Sally F. Brown to them the last above named four persons and to each of their heirs and assigns forever.

12thly. I give and bequeath to Elizabeth Corbett three hundred dollars in cash or good bonds to her the said Elizabeth Corbett and to her heirs and assigns forever.

13thly. I give and bequeath to Sally Corbett wife to Thomas Corbett all the right and title which I have in and to the tract of land whereon the said Thomas Corbett now lives for and during the life of her the said Sally Corbett and at her death I give the said tract of land to the children of the said Sally Corbett the same to be equally divided amongst all of the said children and each of them, their heirs and each of them forever.

14thly. I give and bequeath to William Drake the sum of three hundred dollars in cash or good bonds to him and to his heirs and assigns forever.

15thly. I give and bequeath to James Drake the sum of two hundred dollars in cash or good bonds to him the said James Drake for and during his own natural life of at his death I give the same to Samuel Drake his son. I further give to the said Thomas Drake the further sum of one hundred dollars in cash or good bonds both of which sums as yet, I have advanced to him the said Thomas Drake and to his heirs and assigns forever.

16thly. I give and bequeath to Martha Reel daughter of Benjamin Reel all the right debt, interest and estate which I have in and to the parcel of land appraised by Volney Reel due to his son Benjamin Reel for his own natural life and at his death to the children of the said Benjamin Reel the same to be equally divided between the children of the said Benjamin Reel to her the said Martha Reel and to her heirs and assigns forever.
