 W^m W. Webb Administrator of the Court having returned an account of James St. Edwards' administration of the estate of Alfred Spence dec^d and also an account of all debts & demands against the estate of Spence dec^d proved before him & they having laid on oath (and referred in the Probate Office) there being no exceptions thereto were examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded. And it further ordered that the Administrator appertain the amount in his hands amongst the several creditors who have proved their debts as aforesaid, the same not being sufficient to pay the whole amount and after ascertaining the amount due each party, each the amount ordered to be due and make report to Court.
