Year Commissioner reports to the Court that upon the 1st day of February 1857, J.R. Edwards the Administrator of George A.H. Newson deceased exhibited before your Commissioner a statement of all the money which he the said J.R. Edwards had received or become chargeable with or had disbursed together with the vouchers for each disbursements. That the said Commissioner embraced the said Administrator in the list of beneficiaries whose accounts were before him for settlement which was posted at the front door of the Commissioners Office in the first day of February last, on the day after his report (in days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned in the said list) made up and completed the summing up amount of the said J.R. Edwards (Administrator) of the estate of the said George A.H. Newson deceased (on the 18th day of February 1857) finds balance of £ 1815. 21/- due from the Commissioner to the said estate with interest thereon from the 1st day of March 1857. The account is supported by satisfactory vouchers (and all the debts paid on the first day) except the debts paid R. H. Bygate, John Earle &c &c of the estate of the said Newson (and is herewith returned).
