In the name of God, Amen! I, Jacob Ramsay of the County of Southampton, being of sound mind, but feeble in health, do make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament touching all other wills that may have been made by me heretofore.

Item 1st I will that all my just debts and funeral expenses shall be first paid.

Item 2nd I give unto my two daughters Sarah A. Ramsay and Elizabeth L. Moe Lewis one Fourth part and clothing which they now have in possession and one Bee have a piece, to them and their heirs forever.

Item 3rd I give unto my son James M. Ramsay all the balance of my personal estate of every description. And wot that my said son James shall raise to manhood if he shall live Elias E. Fells son of Mary Fells and send him to school until he shall have attained a common English education and put him to some Mechanical trade, by which he can live, and wot that my son James shall fail to comply I then will that all of the above property shall be sold and one half of the proceeds to go into the hands of Robt L. Jones who I wish to take charge of said Elias E. Fells and apply his portion on him as I have directed above. And wot that my son James or Elias E. Fells shall die without leaving Lawful issue, then I will that the other shall receive his portion.
