To the County Court of Southampton County,

Your Commissioner reports to the Court that on the 7th day of March 1857, Strington Sanders executor of William Darns dec'd. exhibited before him a statement of all the money which he received or became chargeable with or distributed or disbursed up to the 20th May 1857, together with the vouchers for such disbursements. That the Commissioner embraced therein accounts on the list of Commissioners whose accounts were before him for settlement, which was posted at the front door of the Court-house of said County on the first day of April Court last and on the date of this report (ten days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned in the said list) made up and completed the facing account of the said Strington Sanders Executorial proceedings in the estate of the said William Darns dec'd and on the 20th day of May 1857 found a balance of \$298.87 due from the said Executor to the said estate, with interest thereon from the 1st day of September 1857. The Commissioner having allowed the Executor six months time to invest the balance due by him from the time of its receipt or the time it became due. The account is sustained by satisfactory vouchers and is herewith returned.

Your Commissioner further reports to the Court, that he has examined whether the said Executor has given such bond as the Law requires (and whether it is in a pecuniary and with securities sufficient) and finds the same to be satisfactory and fully sufficient, he believes.
