To the County Court of Southampton County.

Your Commissioner reports to the Court that on the 1st day of September last, Robert S. Jones, administrator of L. M. Jones dec^d exhibited before him a Statement of all the moneys which he the said Adm. had received or become chargeable with or had disbursed from 1st May 1856 to the 1st Sept. 1857 together with the vouchers for such disbursements. That the Comr. embraced the said adm. in list of fiduciaries, whose accounts were before him for settlement, which was posted at the first term of the Court since adjourned, on the first of September Court last (and on the date of this report (ten days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned in the said list) made up and completed the foregoing account of the said Robt S. Jones' administration of the estate of the said L. M. Jones dec^d on the 1st day of Sept. 1857 finds a balance of \$ 157 36 due from the adm. to said estate of which \$ 56.34 is Interest. The account is supported by valid fasting vouchers.

Your Commissioner further reports to the Court that he has examined whether the said Adm. has given such bond as the law requires (and whether it is in a penalty and with sureties sufficient and finds the same to be good and fully sufficient.
