

In the name of God, Amen: I, Isaac H. Davis of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, considering the uncertainty of human life and being of a sound and disposing mind, do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following, viz:

Item 1st I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Sarah E. Davis all the property of my kind possessed by her previous to our marriage.

Item 2nd It is my wish and desire that at my death or as soon after as practicable, that all my negroes one excepted shall be sold in this County at public Auction for cash and that all land shall also be sold in a like sort, the payment left disposable with my Executrix.

Item 3rd It is my wish and desire that twelve hundred Dollars arising from the sale of the property sole to me by Thos. S. Ivory shall be placed in some Savings Institution for the support of the said Thomas S. Ivory during his life.

Item 4th I give and bequeath to daughter Harriet H. Davis Three Thousand Dollars as soon as practicable after my death, and it is my wish that the remainder of my money best be placed in a common fund, the annual interest arising therefrom to be appropriated to the education and support of my younger children as follows viz: It is my wish that my sons Adolphus H. and Isaac H. shall be sent to some good school for two years or more if necessary and it is also my wish that my children Samuel R., Carolina M. and my youngest (not yet named) shall be supported and educated in like manner out of the same fund.

Item 5th I leave one hundred dollars (named But) excepted out of Item 3rd my beloved wife Sarah E. Davis as a mite for my youngest child until she may be large enough to go to school, and then I desire her to be sold as the others and the mite placed in the same fund.

Item 6th I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Sarah E. Davis Fifty Dollars annually during her life or widowhood.

Item 7th It is my wish that in case the interest arising from the aforesaid fund shall be insufficient for the support and education of my children as above named the my executors shall take so much of the principal as may be necessary.

Item 8th It is my wish and desire that when my youngest child shall have finished her education that all the moneys belonging to my estate shall be divided as follows viz: I give and bequeath to my son Adolphus G. Davis Twenty Five Dollars and the remainder equally divided among all my living children except my daughter Rebecca Jane, and the portion which would fall to her under equal distribution, I give and bequeath to her children: But in the event that either of my children should die leaving children before the aforesaid fund shall be divided, then I give and bequeath that child's portion to his or her children as the case may be.

Item 9th I nominate and appoint my friend Thos. M. Newman Executrix of this my last Will and Testament.
