To the County Court of Southampton County.

Your Commissaries reports to the Court that Archibald D. Hargreave requests him to make up the foregoing account of his transactions as Commissary of Robert Hargreave dec^d. The account is sustained by satisfactory vouchers. The Commissaries state especially at the request of the Com^r's Trustee that the whole of the estate of the said decedent was under a deed of trust for the benefit of John Hargreave and did not sell for enough to pay the same and consequently the estate was insolvent. The Commissaries entered with said Archibald in the list of Fiduciaries whose accounts were before him for settlement which was posted at the front door of the Court house of said County on the 1st day of September Court 1857 and on the date of his report (ten days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned in the said list) made up and completed the foregoing account.

Your Commissaries further reports that he has examined whether the said Com^r's Trustee has given such bond as the Law requires and that the same most judiciously and fully sufficient in personalty and with sufficient securities.
