To the County Court of Southampton County.

Your Commissioner reports to the Court that on the 25th day of Sept. 1857 Elizabeth Gordon Administratrix of Jacob Gordon dec'd. exhibited before you Commissioner a statement of all the money which she said Elizabeth Gordon had received or become chargeable with or had disbursed up to that date together with vouchers for such disbursements. That the Commissioner embraced the said account in the list of fiduciaries whose accounts were before him for settlement, which was posted at the first door of the Courtroom of said County on the first day of October last on the date of this report (ten days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned in the said list) made up and completed the foregoing account of Elizabeth Gordon Administratrix on the estate of Jacob Gordon dec'd on the 25th day of September 1857 finds a balance of \$307.86 due from the said Elizabeth Gordon estate, all principal. The account is supported by satisfactory vouchers and is herewith returned. Your Commissioner further reports to the Court that the bond given by the said Elizabeth Gordon has been examined by him and he finds it such as the Law requires and is a penalty and with securities sufficient, he
