Your Commissioners reports to the Court that on the 9th day of July 1857 James H. Pusey the Administrator of Elizabeth D. Pollockham deceased exhibited before your Commission a statement of all the moneys which he the said James H. Pusey had received from the estate chargeable with a bad debtors up to the 19th May 1857 together with the vouchers for such disbursements. That the said Commissioner embraced the said administrator in the list of fiduciaries whose accounts were before him for settlement, which was posted at the front door of the Courtroom of said County, on the first day of July last and on the date of this report (ten days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned and embraced made up and completed the foregoing account of the said James H. Pusey's administration of the estate of the said Elizabeth D. Pollockham Comr on that day, to wit; the 1st day of October 1857, finds a balance of \$462.73 due from the Administrator to the said estate with interest thereon from that day.
