In the name of God, Amen: I, Henry Council of the County of Southampton and
 State of Virginia do make and ordain this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all
 other and former wills made by me at any time.

I give and bequeath to my son Joseph Council all of my Lands South of the
 commoning at a person on tree in James Haulfies Line near his gate three down
 nearly a west course to a post there to a new cut gum thence to a blacked gum,
 thence down to a post and at the gum Council so called a corner line in feet Council
 line to him and his heirs forever except five wood or timber of any kind which my wife
 Martha Council may use during her life for her own consumption.

I leave to my beloved wife Martha Council all of my Lands north of the aforesaid
 Run dango with all of my chattel estate viz: horse, cows, hogs, sheep, corn, fodder,
 peas, potatoes, farming utensils, and all my apple trees, shall if except giving
 my son Joseph Council the liberty of gathering and stilling all the apples and
 apple juice that he may make in his own premises also household and kitchen
 at his house.

And at his death I give and bequeath to my son Henry Council all
 of my Lands north of the aforesaid Run dango to him and his heirs forever and
 further more at the death of my beloved wife, I give and bequeath to my two sons
 Joseph Council and Henry Council all of my chattel to be equally divided be
 tween them after paying to Emily Gould Margaret Hazzell, Benjamin Council,
 George M. Council and Sally Council the sum of one dollar each at being the
 sum I give and bequeath to each of them in my last will and Testament, Hence
 James Rieister my Sole Executor.
