In the name of God, Amen. I, Henry Council of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia do make and ordain this my last will and Testament hereby declaring that and former wills made by me at any time.

Stout. I gave and began with to my son Joseph Larned all of my Lands South of Cape
commencing at a perpendicular tree in James Mansfield Lino near his gate thence down
nearly a west course to a pine thence to a short gum thence to a black gum,
thence down to a perpendicular in the gum brook so called a corner tree in Joe Larned
line to land and his heirs forever Except five wood or timber of any kind which my wife
Metta Larned may use & dispose of for her own consumption.

Item. I lend to my beloved wife Martha Bennett all of my Lands north of the aforesaid
Boundary with all of my chattel estate viz: hives, cows, hogs, sheep, corn, fodder,
peas, potatoes, farming utensils, and all my apple works, save & except giving
my son Joseph Bennett the liberty of girding and stilling all the apples and
apple juice that he may make in his own premises also his kitchen and kitchen
in full and free.

And at his death I give and bequeath to my son Henry Council all of my lands north of the aforesaid River & to him and his heirs forever and his two sons Joseph Council and Henry Council all of my chattels to be equally divided between them after paying to Emily Gould Margaret Wozel, Benjamin Council, George M. Council and Sally Council the sum of one dollar each at twenty the sum I give and bequeath to each of them in my last will and testament. I leave James Ruster my sole Executor.
