To the County Court of Southampton County:

Your Commissioner reports to the Court that on the 14th day of September 1857 Simon Mumf., Comr. of Simon Mumf. dec'd. Comr. of Josiah Mumf. dec'd. exhibited before your Commissioner a statement of all the money which he said Simon Mumf. had received or become chargeable with or had disbursed during his life as administrator laid together with the vouchers for such disbursements. That the Commissioner embraced
