Your Commissioners reports to the Court that on the 17th day of Sept. 1857, James M. Murphy, Exor. of Simon Murphy dec'd. who was Adm'r. of Sarah L. Wells dec'd. exhibited before your Commissioners a Statement of all the moneys which he the said Simon Murphy had received or became chargeable with or had disbursed during his life together with vouchers for such disbursements. That the Commissioners embraced thereon (Commissioners notes) without objection whose accounts were before him for settlement which was posted at the front door of the Court house of said County on the first day of September Court last (and on the date of this report ten days having elapsed since said account was mentioned in said list) made up an completed the foregoing account of the said Simon Murphy's Administration of the estate of Sarah L. Wells deceased and on the 25th day of September 1858 finds a balance of \$89.10 & due from the Adm'r. to the said estate of which sum \$11.85 is interest. The said balance has been transferred by the Commissioners to the account of the administrators actions with M^{rs} M. Wells the father of the said Sarah L. Wells and the same has as will be seen by reference to the said account. The account is supported by satisfactory vouchers &c.
