To the County Court of Southampton County:

Your Commissioners reports to the Court that on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of September 1857, James Mel Musgrove Esq<sup>r</sup> of Simon Musgrove dec<sup>d</sup> who was donee of Matthew White deceased exhibited before your Commissioners a statement of all the money which he the said Simon Musgrove had received or become chargeable with or had disbursed during his life together with the vouchers for such disbursements. That the Commissioners returned the said Com<sup>rs</sup> in the list of fiduciaries whose accounts were before them for settlement which was posted at the front door of the Court house of said County on the first day of September Court last and on the date of this report (ten days having elapsed since the said account was returned in the said list) made and completed the foregoing amount of the said Simon Musgrove's administration of the estate of the said Matthew White dec<sup>d</sup> and on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September 1857 finds a balance of \$95.58 due from the administrator to the said estate of which sum \$12.36 is interest. The Commissioners has transferred the foregoing balance to the account of the said administrator's transactions with Mel<sup>l</sup> J<sup>r</sup> White the father of the said Matthew White an the Court Law. The account is supported by satisfactory vouchers given under my hand, as Commissioner of said Court, on the day and year first aforesaid.
