To the County Court of Southampton County:

Upon Commissioner's reports to the Court that on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of September 1857 James Old Mudge Ex<sup>or</sup> of Simon Mudge dec<sup>d</sup>. who was adm<sup>r</sup> of Mary P. Little dec<sup>d</sup>. exhibits before your Commissioner a statement of all the money which he had dec<sup>d</sup>. exhibits before your Commissioner a statement of all the money which he had become chargeable with or received or had disbursed during his life together with the vouchers for such disbursements. That the Commissioner embraced therein some in the list of fiduciaries whose accounts were before him for settlement, which was posted at the front of the Courtroom of said County on the first day of Sept<sup>r</sup> Court last and on the date of this report (ten days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned in said list) made up and completed foregoing account of the said Simon Mudge (Commissioner of the estate of the said Mary P. Little dec<sup>d</sup>. and in the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September 1857 finds a balance of \$777.23 due from the adm<sup>r</sup> to the said estate of which sum \$9.23 is interest. The said balance the Commissioner has transferred to the account of the adm<sup>r</sup> to be loaned out with interest to the said Little the father of the said Mary P. Little and the Heir at Law
