To the County Court of Southampton County.

Your Commissioner in reply to the Court that on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December 1857 James H. Burns administrator of a Will of Allen Spence deceased exhibited before your Commissioner a statement of his transactions since the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December 1856 - Your Commissioner further stated at the request of the Court that there has been a previous account of his transactions made out by Wm. Cobb and that the same Commissioner took an account of the Debts or Demands against the said Allen Spence deceased in his estate and that there was not enough in his hands to pay them that the creditors agreed to take the principal of the said Debts in his share of the same which the Court paid them.

That the said Commissioner submitted the said administrator's indebtedness of persons whose accounts were before him for settlement which was posted at the first term of the Court house of said County on the first day of December Court last and on the date of this report (ten days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned in the said report) made up and completed the foregoing account. The account is sustained by satisfactory vouchers and has been returned and your Court complies with the other requisitions of the Law.
