To the County Court of Southampton County:

Your Commissioner reports to the Court that on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of December 1857 James St. Person administrator of a late Spouse deceased exhibited before your Commissioner a statement of his transactions since the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December 1856 - Your Commissioner further states at the request of the Admin. that there has been a general account of his transactions made out by Leon Cobb and that the same contained took an account of the debts or demands against the said Allen Spouse, on his estate and that there was not enough in his hands to pay them that the creditors agreed to take the principal of the said debts in discharge of the same which the Admin. paid them.

That the said Commissioner entreated the said administrator whether all his accounts were before him for settlement which was posted at the first door of the Committee of said County on the first day of December Court last and on the date of this report ten days having elapsed since the said account was mentioned in the said door made up and completed the foregoing account. The amount is sustained by satisfactory evidence and herewith retained and given to the Court complete with the other requisitions of the law.
