Your Commissioner reports to you that Thomas Ridley the agent
 of Robert Ridley has exhibited before him a statement of all money
 received by the said Thomas Ridley or with which he had become charged
 or had disbursed during the period embraced in the foregoing account.
 together with the vouchers in support of the disbursements. The
 funds balance of \$25028.48 to be due by the said Thomas
 Ridley to the said Robert Ridley on the 31st day of Decr 1857, and
 interest thereon from that day. That the said account is supported
 by satisfactory vouchers and that the said Thomas Ridley has given
 such bond as the law requires, the penalty whereof and the sum
 thereon are unobjectionable in the opinion of the Commissioner and
 sufficient. That the said Thomas Ridley was embraced in the
 list of Seditionaries posted up at the front door of the Court House
