

Battle the executor of Henry Harrison has exhibited before him a statement of all monies received by the said Edward Butts or with which he had become chargeable in his hands, during the period embraced in the foregoing account, together with the vouchers in support of the disbursements. That he finds a balance of £249 8s 6d due by the said Edward Butts to the said Henry Harrison on the 15th day of February 1858, with interest on £224 0s 0d from that day. That the said account is supported by satisfactory vouchers and that the said Edward Butts has given such bond as the law requires, the penalty whereof and the summing thereof is unobjectionable and sufficient in the opinion of the Commissioner. That the said Edward Butts was embraced in the list of debtors posted up at the front door of the Court House of Southampton County on the first of February Court last, one month & day, (ten days having elapsed since the same was thus posted up) the foregoing account was made up and completed.
