 & The Balance of my estate both real and personal I give to my infant Martha W. Jones to her and request that the County Court of Sweet-
 nington will allow her to qualify without giving Security, Given under
 my hand this 3rd day of November 1856.

At a Court held in the County of Southampton, September 20th 1858.

A Meeting purporting to be the last Will and Testament of Robt. S. Jones deceased was this day produced to the Court and there being no Objecting witness thereon James H. Davis and Nathan W. Thomas being first duly sworn do prove and say that they are well acquainted with the handwriting of the said Robert S. Jones deceased and they duly believe that the said will and the name thereon are wholly in the handwriting of the said Robert S. Jones deceased whereupon the said writing was ordered to be read as the last Will and Testament of the said Robert S. Jones deceased. And in the motion of Martha W. Jones, the Executing Trustee named who with others am called into and acknowledge a sum in the penalty of Five hundred Dollars conditioned according to Law (but without Security) the will regarding that none should be required of having Certificate so granted her for obtaining a probate after said will in due form.
