Jerusalem, December 1st 1869

To the County Court of Southampton County, Your Commissioner reports to the Court that on the 18th day of October last, at the request of W^m B. Shantz one of the Creditors of the decedent, he appointed the 22nd day of November last, at his Office at the Court house of said County, for receiving proof of debts or demands against the said decedent or his Estate and for the presentation of said claims and plans to the Creditors of the said Estate and all others concerned, at the first term of the Court of said County at the first day of two successive terms of the County Court of said County to wit, at October and November Terms last. That the several Creditors of the said Estate whose names are mentioned in the foregoing account, appeared before the Commissioner at his said Office, and exhibited and proved to satisfaction of your Commissioner their several debts or demands against the said decedent or his Estate, as set forth in said account; Upon which the said Commissioner has computed the interest up to the date of this Report and classified them according to their respective legal dignities and on the date of this Report finds the aggregate amount of said debts or demands inclusive of interest to be (\$156.58) One hundred and fifty six dollars and fifty eight Cents, I have under my hand as Commissioner of the said Court the day and year first aforesaid.

At a Court held for the County of Southampton, on Monday the 17th day of January 1870, It appearing by a Report of Commissioner Isaac White, who has settled Samuel Kelle's administrative account of Margaret Wilson decd, that there is a balance due to the Estate of \$156.53 cts, and it also appearing from a Report of the debts and liabilities against the Estate that there is the sum of \$156.58 Cents due the Creditors of the said Estate; Therefore this day this Cause came on to be heard on the said Reports to which no exceptions have been filed and was argued by counsel; No consideration being the Court doth adjudge, Order and decree, that the said Reports be confirmed, and that Samuel Kelle pay to William B. Shantz the sum of \$92.27 and to John Wood and the sum of \$64.31
