

Commissioneer's Office.

Jerusalem, December 1<sup>st</sup> 1869

To the County Court of Southampton County, Your Commissioneer reports to the Court that  
 on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of October last, at the request of Wm. B. Shantz one of the Creditors  
 of the decedent, he appointed the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of November last, at his Office at  
 the Court house of said County, for receiving proof of Debts & demands against the  
 said decedent or her Estate as parties or parties of said time and place to the  
 Creditors of the said Estate and all others concerned, at the front door of the Courts  
 house of said County on the first day of two Successive terms of the County Court of  
 said County to wit, at October and November Terms last. That the several Creditors  
 of the said Estate whose names are mentioned in the foregoing account, appeared  
 before the Commissioneer at his said Office, and exhibited and proved to satisfaction  
 of your Commissioneer their several debts & demands against the said decedent  
 or her Estate, as set forth in said account; Upon which the said Commissioneer  
 has computed the interest up to the date of this Report and classified them  
 according to their respective legal dignities and on the date of this  
 Report finds the aggregate amount of said debts & demands inclusive of  
 interest to be (\$154.58) One hundred and fifty four dollars and fifty  
 Eight Cents. Now Under my hand as Commissioneer of the said County

At a Court held for the County of Southampton, on Monday the 17<sup>th</sup> day of  
 January 1870, It appearing by a Report of Commissioneer John White,  
 who has settled Sam'l Kello's administrative account of Martha Wilson died,  
 that there is a balance due to the Estate of \$154.53 etc, and it also  
 appearing from a Report of the debts outstanding against the Estate that  
 there is the sum of \$156.58 cents due the Creditors of the said Estate  
 Therefore this day this cause came to be heard on the said  
 Report to which no exceptions have been filed and was argued by  
 counsel, to consideration whereof the Court did adjudge, Order  
 and direct, that the said Report be Confirmed, and that Sam'l  
 Kello pay to William B. Shantz the sum of \$92.37 and to  
 John Woodard the sum of \$64.31
