Juncobent, August 34th 1858

Your Commissioner reports to the Court, that in the 31st day of December 1857 at the request of Elliott L. May the Administrator of the estate of James P. Backus dec'd he appointed the 30th day of February 1858, at his office, at the Courthouse of said County for receiving proof of debts & demands against the said decedent or his estate and for the notice of said time and place to the creditors of the said estate and all other concerned at the first door of the Courthouse of said County, on the first day of the next term of the County Court of said County, to-wit: 1st January and February terms 1858. That the several creditors of the said estate whose names are mentioned in the foregoing account appeared before the Commissioner, at the Office aforesaid, upon the day specified in the notice and on the days to which the account was adjourned (the same having been adjourned from day to day to the 16th day of July 1858) and exhibited and proved to the satisfaction of your Commissioner their several debts & demands against the said decedent or his estate as set forth in the said account, upon which the Commissioner has computed interest up to the date of the 16th day of July 1858, and on that day finds the aggregate amount of said debts & demands inclusive of interest to be \$4387.16 and all of the 3rd & 11th Clauses.
