Yours Commissioner report to the Court, that in the 31st day of December 1857
 at the request of Elliott L. Story the Administrator of the estate of James S. Eastman deceased,
 appointed the 3d ^{day} of February 1858, at his office, at the Comthouse of said County for
 receiving proof of debts demands against the said decedent or his estate and parts,
 notice of such time and place to the creditors of the said estate (in all other cases)
 of the first door of the Comthouse of said County, in the first day after same from
 said County Court of said County, ten o'clock A.M. January and February term 1858.
 That the several creditors of the said estate whose names are mentioned in the account
 appeared before the Commissioner, at the Office aforesaid, upon the day
 specified in the notice and on the days to which the account was adjourned (the
 same having been adjourned from day to day to the 16th day of July 1858)
 and exhibited and proved to the satisfaction of said Commissioner their several
 debts or demands against the said decedent or his estate as set forth in said
 account, upon which the Commissioner has computed interest up to the
 date of the 16th day of July 1858, and on that day finds the aggregate
 amount of said debts or demands inclusive of interest to be \$438^{71/2} and
 all of the 3^d of 4th Clerks.
