Davis \$1.⁰⁰ to Christing Morris \$2.⁰⁰ to A. A. Dwyer \$11.⁴⁵ to Saml Kells \$1.⁴⁵ & \$33.⁴⁵ for being their assigned proceeds of the amount in the hands of the said Andrew J. Kells, as administrator aforesaid with interest as aforesaid amounts from the 5th day of October 1858. All paid.
