Your Commissioners report to Court that William Stephenson the Administrator of Sops. McComb has exhibited before him a statement of all moneys received by the said Administrator or used which he had become chargeable or had disbursed during the period within of the foregoing account together with the vouchers in support of the said balance of \$18.67 to be due by the said Administrator to the said estate of the said Sops. as of August 1855, with interest thereon from that day.
