To the County Court of Southampton County.

Your Commissioner reports to Court that Oliver H. Sumner the Administrator of Elizabeth Sumner has exhibited before him a statement of all moneys received by the said Administrator in which he has become chargeable as he disbursed during the periods embraced in the foregoing account together with the vouchers in support of the disbursements. That he finds a balance of \$263.51 due by the said Administrator to the said estate on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of August 1858, with interest on \$248.29 paid thereof on that day. That the said account is supported by satisfactory vouchers, and that the said Administrator has given such bond as the law requires, the penalty whereof and the vouchers thereon are sufficient in the opinion of the Commissioner.
