At a Court held for the County Southampton February 21<sup>st</sup> 1859 -

The account of Samuel Kelle, Administrator on the estate of Joseph C. Ferguson deceased. The account of all debts demanded, against Joseph C. Ferguson deceased or his estate, and the account apportioning the amount in the hands of the Administrator of Joseph C. Ferguson deceased amongst the several creditors who have proved their debts according to Law, having severally paid one month and upwards in the Clerks Office (and their being no exceptions thereto), was severally examined, confirmed and ordered to be recited. And the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that Samuel Kelle the administrator of the said Joseph C. Ferguson deceased out of the amount in his hands as administrator, to James J. Davison £14.30, & £3.49, Edward Beaton £10.30, £14.80, £3.20, Soper & Munfer £9.39, £7.89, & £3.63, James Barnes £10.77, £7.10, Richd B. Ferguson attorney of C. T. Hill £1.96, Richd B. Ferguson £1.18, John R. Rachello £1.33, and Richd L. Bryant attorney of Lewis Wick £1.00. The amount apportioned to each of them is herein a/count, with legal interest on each of said amounts from the 1<sup>st</sup> January 1859, till paid.
