At a Court held for the County Southampton February 2nd 1859 -

The account of Samuel Wells, administrator of the estate of Joseph C. Ferguson deceased. The account of all debts & demands against Joseph C. Ferguson dec'd or his estate, and the account of apportioning the amount in the hands of the Administrator of Joseph C. Ferguson dec'd amongst the several creditors who have proved their debts according to Law having severally laid one month and upwards in the Clerk's Office (and their being no exceptions thereto, was severally examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded. And the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that Samuel Wells the Administrator, do pay to James J. Dandow \$14.80, & \$3.49, Edward Rector \$10.30, & \$3.20, Pope & Murfee \$9.39, & \$7.89, & \$3.53, James Barnes \$4.75, & \$3.20, Richard B. Ferguson assignee of C. F. Hill \$1.95, Richard B. Ferguson \$1.35, John R. Rochelle \$1.33. And should L. Bryant assignee of Lewis Vick with legal amounts apportioned to each of them in showing a account with legal interest on each of said amounts from the 1st January 1859, till paid.
