

In the name of God, Amen! I, William Thomas Buell of the County and State of Virginia, do hereby make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to

say 1<sup>st</sup>. After my death I desire that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of my estate by my executor herein after named.

Item 2<sup>nd</sup>. I send my Executor as soon as he thinks best to sell my two negroes Anna and Sally and all other property I leave not disposed of except my land that I want sold about the fall or winter after my death.

Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I wish my Executor to purchase two Tomb Stones for myself and wife and put them up over our graves also to have half an acre of land around the grave and plant it and at the sale of my Land I wish that half acre including the grave yet reserved for my family burying ground and not sold at all.

Item 4<sup>th</sup> I give to my son Benjamin C. Buell my Silver Watch and Five hundred Dollars in money or good bonds to him and his heirs forever.

Item 5<sup>th</sup> I give to my Daughter Mary A. Buell one good bed and furniture and Five hundred Dollars to her and heirs forever.

Item 6<sup>th</sup> I give to my Daughter Cornelia C. Buell one good bed and furniture and Six hundred Dollars to her and heirs forever.

Item 7<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my son James D. Buell one thousand Dollars to him and his heirs forever and I wish him to be sent to a good school by my executor being enough to give him a pretty fair common education and my executor is to pay all reasonable expenses of Board, Tutoring, Clothes &c out of his share of my estate, I also want my son Benjamin C. Buell to be sent to a good school one year and his expenses to be paid out of his part of my estate for Board, clothes Tutoring &c.

Item 8<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my son Mills H. Buell Two hundred Dollars to him and his heirs forever and I wish my Executor to send him to a good school being enough to give him a pretty good common education and my Executor is to pay all of his expenses of Board, Room, Clothes &c out of his portion of my estate and if he should die before he arrives to the age of twenty one years then in that case I wish the balance of his portion equally divided between my two Daughters Mary A. Buell and Cornelia C. Buell unless he should leave a lawful child a child then in that case his portion is to go to his children no matter what his age be under twenty one years old when he dies.

Item 9<sup>th</sup> My will is that if anything is left of my estate after paying off all the bequests and Legacies of my will then I wish that part equally divided between my five children Mary A. Buell, Cornelia C. Buell, Benjamin C. Buell, James D. Buell and Mills H. Buell to them and their heirs forever.

Item 10<sup>th</sup> My will is this if either of my before named children should die before they arrive to the age of twenty one years that their portion shall be equally divided between the survivors except my son Mills H. Buell if he dies I have already disposed of his portion and I want it to be divided as I have stated in Item the 8<sup>th</sup>. But if either of the others should marry and die leaving a lawful child or children before they are twenty one years old then their portion is to go to their children, but if they leave no lawful child it is to go to the survivors as stated in the first part of this Item.

Item 11<sup>th</sup> and lastly I hereby nominate and appoint my friend James J. Dandridge Executor of this my last will and Testament hereby making and amending all other former wills or Testaments by me hitherto made -
