To the County Court of Southampton County.

Your Commissioner reports to Court that James Barnes the Executor of Jacob Barnes has exhibited before him a statement of all money received by the said Executor or with which he had become chargeable or had disbursed during the period embraced in the foregoing account, together with the vouchers in support of the disbursements.
