To the Hon'ble Court of Southampton County

Our Commissioner reports to me that William Edwards one of the Executors of William V. Edwards has exhibited before him a statement of all moneys received by the said Executor with which he had become chargeable or had disbursed, during the period embraced in the foregoing account, together with the vouchers in support of the disbursements. That he finds a balance of \$4957.71 to be due by the said Executor to the said estate on the 31st day of December 1888, with interest on \$4784.58 from that day and on \$170.16 from 31st Jan'y 1889.
