To the Hon'ble Court of Southampton County.

Your Commissioner reports to Court that John W. Harrison the Executor of Henry Moore dec'd. has exhibited before him a statement of all moneys received by the said Executor or with which he had become chargeable or had disbursed during the periods embraced in the foregoing account, together with the vouchers in support of that disbursement. That he finds a balance of \$378. 59 to be due by the said Executor to the said estate on the 15th day of March 1859, with interest thereon from that day.
