To the County Clerk of Southampton County.

Your Commissioner reports to you that Wmth D. Shands the Administrator of S. M. Howell has exhibited before him a Statement of all moneys received by the said Administrator or with which he had become chargeable or had disbursed during the period embraced in the foregoing account together with the vouchers in support of the disbursements.
