

Stick, John H. I, John H. Stick, being of sound mind, but wishing to prepare my worldly affairs for the contingency of death, do make and ordain this as my last will and testament.

Item 1st. I give and bequeath to my friend Dr. Miles Starks the sum of three hundred dollars to him and his heirs forever.

Item 2nd. I give and devise to my beloved wife Georgianna, the balance of my estate of every kind whatsoever, during her life & widowhood, but at her death or marriage, I give and devise to the children that may be living on the occurrence of either of said contingencies, of Mrs. Devanny Claiborne One third of my said estate of every kind, and the other two thirds also lately to my said wife and her heirs forever. But the whole of this 2nd clause is to be taken in the event that my said wife should have no issue by virtue of her marriage with me who may reach the age of twenty one years or many, for in this latter event I wish my said wife to take what the law may allow her and the other two thirds to go to my said child.

But should she have no issue to reach the said age of twenty one years or many, then I wish the whole of said (except the said three hundred dollars) to be disposed of as stated in the beginning of this second clause.

Mason, his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged abroad in the penalty of twenty thousand dollars conditioned according to law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration with the will of the said John H. Stick dec^d. in due form.
