To the County Court of Southampton County.

Your Commissioner reports to the Court that Wm. W. Briggs, Sheriff and the Administrator of James Edwards has exhibited before him a statement of all moneys received by the said Administrator or with which he had become chargeable, during the periods embraced in the foregoing account, together with the vouchers in support of the disbursements. That he finds a balance of \$6.39 to be due by the said Administrator to the said estate on the 1st day of April 1859 with interest at \$74.76 from that day.
