To the County Court of Southampton County.

Your Commissioner reports to the Court that on the 13th July 1858 at the request of Wm. H. Briggs Sheriff of said County of James Edwards dec'd he appointed the 17th day of August 1858 at his office at the Courthouse of said County for receiving proof of debts & demands against the said dec'd or his estate and posted notice to the creditors and all others concerned at the front door of the Courthouse of said County, on the first day of two successive terms of the County Court of said County, to wit; at July and August terms 1858. That the several creditors of the said estate whose names are mentioned in the foregoing account appeared before the Commissioner at his office upon the day specified in the notice and exhibited and proved to the satisfaction of your Commissioner their several debts & demands against the said dec'd or his estate as set forth in the said account upon which the Commissioner has computed interest up to the 1st day of April 1859, and on that day finds the aggregate amount of said debts & demands inclusive of interest to be \$107.43 of all of the same class.
