Wren \$31.22, James Cook \$2.38, Wilky Diggs \$22.14, A. B. J. & B. Urquhart \$69.39, R. J. Bailey \$3.90, Alex. Faison \$2.95, Horn & Harris \$4.43, Goodman & Son \$3.15, & Satsay Holliman \$6.22 with interest on each of said amounts from the 1st day of May 1860, all paid.
