To the County Court of Southampton County.

Your Commissioner reports to Court that Allen Edwards the Executor of Copeland has exhibited before him a Statement of all money received by the said Executor or with which he had become chargeable or had disbursed during the periods embraced in the foregoing account, together with the vouchers in support of the disbursements. That he finds a balance of \$112. 65 1/4 to be due by the said estate to the said Executor on the 18th day of August 1860, with interest thereon from that day.
