To the County Court of Southampton County.

Your Commissioner reports to Court that Josiah P. Gay the administrator of Jesse H. Johnson has exhibited before him a statement of all moneys received by the said Administrator or with which he had become chargeable or had disbursed during the periods embraced in the foregoing account together with the vouchers in support of the disbursements. That he finds a balance of \$488.89 to be due by the said Administrator to the said estate on the 20th day of June 1860, with interest on \$766.40 from that day. That the said account is supported by satisfactory vouchers, and that the said Administrator has given such bond as the law requires, the penalty whereof and the securities thereto are sufficient in the opinion of the Court's Commr. That the said Administrator was embraced in the list of Fiduciaries posted up at the front door of the Court House of Southampton County, on the first day of May Court last, and now on this day, (ten days having elapsed since the same was thus posted up) the foregoing account is made up and completed.
