

Item 2nd. I give and bequeath to my daughter Savinia Linnall my portion of the Land called Joseph Sumner place, also twenty five Dollars in cash and one feather bed, to her and her heirs forever.

Item 3rd I give and bequeath to my son John F. Corbitt, my tract of Land called the old place, that I bought of my brother Richard Corbitt held for fifty three acres.

Item 4th I lend to my wife Panny Corbitt her natural life the plantation where I now live called the home tract.

My Will and desire is that all of my chattle Estate that has not been heretofore named be equally divided between my wife Panny Corbitt and my son John F. Corbitt at their own discretion and also at the death of my wife Panny Corbitt, my will and desire is that my son John F. Corbitt to have that tract of Land loaned my wife known as the home tract together with all her portion of chattle Estate that may be found around her at her death to him and his heirs forever.

I hereby nominate and appoint my son John F. Corbitt my whole Executor, annulling all other wills made by me heretofore. Whereunto I have affixed my hand and seal this 28th day of Aug. 1856

At a Court held for the County of Southampton March 18th 1861. This last Will and Testament of William V. Corbitt dec^d was proved by the oaths of William Atkinson and John L. Rowe two of the subscribing witnesses thereto, and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of John F. Corbitt, the executor therein named who made oath and together with William Atkinson and John L. Rowe his securities, (who subscribed on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged abiding in the penalty of one thousand Dollars, conditioned according to law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat of the said will in due form.
