Your Commissioner reports to wit, that George M. Musgrave, the Executor of the will of Nicholas St. Louis has exhibited before him a statement of all moneys received by the said Executor in which the widow has an interest under the will of decedent or with which he had become chargeable or had disbursed during the period embraced in the foregoing account, together with the vouchers in support of the disbursements.
