Ivey or to the possession of any person for him; And further do make a true and just account of his administration within two years after the date of these presents, and all the net and residue of the said proceeds of real estate, goods, chattels, and credits, which shall be found remaining upon his account (the same being first examined and allowed by the Court) shall deliver and pay to each person, as the same shall be due unto persons according to law, and if it shall appear that any last will and testament was made by the deceased and the executor or executors therein named do exhibit the same into Court, making request to have it allowed and approved, and the said Wm. J. Hamell & J. C. Ivey above named bring the same required, do receive and deliver the said letters of administration (probate of such testament being first had and made) in the said Court, then this obligation to be void and of no effect.
